Psychosocial history

Drawn from jail intake and State Hospital social-work notes: raised in Ridgeview County, completed the tenth grade before withdrawing, worked intermittently in warehouse and food-service roles over the following decade. Records describe a period of stable housing with a sibling that ended approximately eighteen months before the index arrest, followed by intermittent homelessness. No record of prior psychiatric hospitalization before this case.

Psychiatric history

Jail intake screening on 02/13/2026 documented disorganized speech, delusional content involving perceived surveillance, and poor insight. State Hospital treatment records trace a trial of risperidone starting 05/03/2026, titrated upward on 05/24/2026 after limited symptom response, with partial improvement in organization of speech noted by 06/2026. Progress notes describe continued fixed delusional beliefs resistant to treatment through the reporting period ending 07/16/2026.

Medical history

No chronic medical conditions are documented in the jail or State Hospital record. Vital signs and basic labs at intake were within normal limits. A single sick-call entry on 03/02/2026 documents a upper-respiratory complaint treated symptomatically; no follow-up was required.

Substance use history

Jail intake self-report and toxicology on 02/11/2026 were positive for cannabis; no other substances detected. Records describe reported daily cannabis use in the year preceding arrest and denied use of alcohol or other substances. No substance-use treatment episodes are documented in the records reviewed.
